- *Grendel* John Gardner ISBN 978-0679723110 The first and most terrifying monster in English literature, from the great early epic Beowulf, tells his own side of the story. This story follows the monster Grendel as he learns about humans and fights the war at the center of the Anglo Saxon classic epic.
- *Atomic Habits* James Clear ISBN 978-0-7352-1129-2 If you are having trouble changing your habits, the problem isn't you. The problems is your system. You do not rise to the level of your goals, you fall to the level of your systems. In *Atomic Habits*, you'll get a plan that can take you to new heights.
